

**INDIAN CREEK VILLAGE, FLORIDA  
OFFICE OF THE VILLAGE MANAGER  
AMENDMENT AND RESTATED  
AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 20-01**

As Village Manager for Indian Creek Village, Florida, and pursuant to the authority vested under the declared State of Emergency due to COVID-19/Novel Coronavirus as well as in accordance with Section 252.38 of the Florida Statutes; I hereby declare the following amended and restated order restricting access to the Village, which will be reasonably and necessarily implemented in response to this State of Emergency (this "Order"):

1. Residential Access. Access by any means to the Village shall be limited to residential property owners/occupants, their immediate family members, guests (not more than 10 guests at any one time), residential employees/personnel and individuals performing property maintenance. Guest visits shall be strictly within the residential property.
2. Non-Residential Access-Indian Creek Country Club. Access by any means to the Village shall be limited to i) Club Members; ii) Club Personnel; and iii) Club Construction Contractors.
  - i. Indian Creek Country Club Members. All Club Members shall have access to the Village for the use of Club facilities actually opened for Member use by the Club (the "Club Facilities") and subject to the following:
    - The Club and all Club Members must fully and strictly comply with the provisions of this Order and all valid and effective Miami-Dade County COVID-19 Emergency Orders, as those orders may be amended from time-to-time, including, but not limited to, Emergency Order No. 21-20 dated April 27, 2020 related to golf course and tennis court operations (the "County Orders").
    - The Club shall provide the Village Public Safety Department with the name of each Club Member who wishes to enter the Village to use the Club Facilities. Those Members will be provided access for that purpose.
  - ii. Club Personnel. Club Personnel shall be provided access to the Village to perform their respective jobs and responsibilities at the Club but for no other purpose and subject to the following:
    - The Club and all Club Personnel must strictly comply with all provisions of this Order and all the County Orders.
    - The Club shall provide the Village Public Safety Department with the names of all Club Personnel who wish to enter the Village to perform their respective jobs. Those personnel will be provided with access for that purpose.

iii. Construction Contractors. Access shall be granted to construction contractors for the sole and exclusive purpose of constructing a replacement dock opposite the Clubhouse and subject to the following:

- Access shall be limited to not more than ten (10) SE Marine Construction Company (“SE Marine”) personnel, including essential subcontractors. SE Marine shall be responsible for providing the names of all such persons to the Village Public Safety Department on a regular basis in advance of access to the Village. Each such person shall be required to provide identification prior to being admitted to the Village.
- In addition to the SE Marine personnel and subcontractors, access to the Village shall be allowed for dump truck drivers hauling construction demolition debris from the dock area to Lot X located in the northeast corner of Bay Drive and the entrance to the Village. No dump truck shall exceed a maximum weight of 10 tons when full. The bed area of the truck must be covered by a screen tarp at all times to prevent the debris from falling from the truck during travel. The use of Lot X for such purposes is governed by separate agreement between the Village and SE Marine.
- Access shall be only during weekdays between 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Vehicular Parking for authorized construction personnel admitted to the Village shall be only on the Country Club Clubhouse property at a Club designated location immediately proximate to the dock.
- SE Marine and all its personnel must strictly comply with this Order and all the County Orders. Any violation of the foregoing conditions shall result in the immediate revocation of access by SE Marine (and subcontractors) to the Village.

Delivery Personnel Access. These access limitations shall not apply to delivery service personnel.

Governmental Access. These access limitations shall not apply to individuals providing essential government services including but not limited to Police and life safety personnel.

Parking. All vehicular parking shall be within each individual lot/ property. No off-site parking shall be permitted.

Enforcement. Village Law Enforcement shall take all necessary actions to enforce this Order, the County Orders and all future orders in accordance with Section 252.47 of the Florida Statutes.

Interpretation and Conflicts. The Village Manager shall be charged with making all interpretations of this Order and any conflict between this Order and the County Orders. This Order may be amended from time-to-time by the Village Manager as deemed necessary by the Village Manager to protect the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents.

Prior Orders. This Order is amended and restated such that it supersedes all prior order and amendments and shall govern all matters of access to the Village during the declared emergency.

I further find that the provisions of this Emergency Order are narrowly tailored and the least restrictive means to achieve the goal of mitigating and slowing the spread of COVID-19. Accordingly, I hereby issue this Order **effective Saturday, May 23, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.** within the jurisdictional limits of Indian Creek Village. This Emergency Order shall expire upon the expiration of the existing Indian Creek Village State of Emergency. This Emergency Order may be cancelled earlier by action of the Village Manager.
